
THE CHAPLET OF THE DIVINE MERCY

Divine Mercy Sunday - First Sunday after Easter

- ♥ The devotion to the Divine Mercy stems from the revelations made to the Polish nun, St. Faustina Kowalska.
- A special request of these visions was that the **first Sunday after Easter** should be the **feast of Divine Mercy**.
- The image of the merciful Jesus is based on a vision of February 1931. Our Lord is pictured in the act of blessing, with two rays, one red and the other pallid (representing blood and water), shining from His heart.
- The words "Jesus, I trust in You" are placed at His feet.
- The **Hour of Mercy** is at **3 pm**, in which the Passion is meditated upon and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy is recited using rosary beads.

The Chaplet of Mercy is recited using ordinary rosary beads of five decades. **1. Make the Sign of the Cross:**

Chaplet of Divine Mercy

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. 2. On rosary beads, pray:

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.

Hail Mary full of Grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed are thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb Jesus.

Holy Mary Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

3. On the Our Father beads, pray:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

4. On the Hail Mary beads, pray ten times:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (10x) Repeat 3 and 4 for the remaining decades.

5. In conclusion, pray each of the following three times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (3x)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You! (3x)

Jesus I trust in You. (3x)
6. End with the Sign of the Cross:
In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
